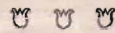


# Petition for a Dispensation for a New Lodge.

*Granted November 16, 1915.*



**To the Grand Master of Free and Accepted Masons of Ohio:**

*Your petitioners represent that they are Free and Accepted Master Masons, who, having the prosperity of the Fraternity at heart, are willing to exert their best endeavors to promote and diffuse the genuine principles of Masonry. For the convenience of their respective dwellings, and for other*

*good reasons, they are desirous of forming a new Lodge in* Cleveland Heights

*County of* Cuyahoga *Ohio,*

*to be named* Heights *Lodge, H. H.*

*In consequence of this desire, and for the good of the Craft, they pray for a Warrant, or Dispensation, to empower them to assemble as a legal Lodge, to discharge the duties of Masonry in the several degrees of Entered Apprentice, Fellow Craft, and Master Mason in a regular and constitutional manner, according to the ancient usages of the Fraternity and the laws and rules of the Grand Lodge.*

*They have nominated, and do recommend, as officers of said proposed Lodge,*

*Bro.* William M. Bogue *a Past Master of a Lodge, to be first Master,*

*Bro.* Chas. A. Tilden *to be first Senior Warden,*

*Bro.* Ernest A. Feazel *to be first Junior Warden,*

*and your petitioners promise, should their prayer be granted, a strict conformance to the Constitution, Code, and By-Laws of the Grand Lodge.*
